## DRIVER TIP SHEET

- 1. Be particularly alert when driving in wildlife areas.
- 2. Drive with increased awareness when traveling in signed wildlife areas. Crossing signs are generally placed in known wildlife movement areas and wildlife-vehicle collision hot spots. Take notice of crossing signs along your regularly traveled routes and avoid getting habituated to them.
- 3. Wildlife are more likely to be found near wooded, wetland or agricultural areas, and wherever roads cross streams.
- 4. Pay attention to both sides of the road by scanning from side to side. If you have passengers, ask them to help you keep an eye out for animals.
