5 SIGNS YOUR NEAR-MISS REPORTING SYSTEM IS FAILING




- **1 IT'S PERCEIVED NEGATIVELY**

Employees view it as a check-the-box exercise at best, and a finger-pointing exercise at worst.
- **2 MEANINGFUL REPORTS ARE UNCOMMON**

The bulk of reported near misses are conditions like worn tools or minor events like insect bites.
- **3 IT DOESN'T HELP**

Employees don't see evidence that reporting near misses helps improve safety.
- **4 FEAR OF REPERCUSSIONS**

Employees worry that reporting a significant near miss will result in a reprimand, or worse.
- **5 IT'S A HASSLE**

Reporting a near miss triggers an onslaught of phone calls and emails to the employees who report them, leaving them saying, "It's not worth it!"

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
