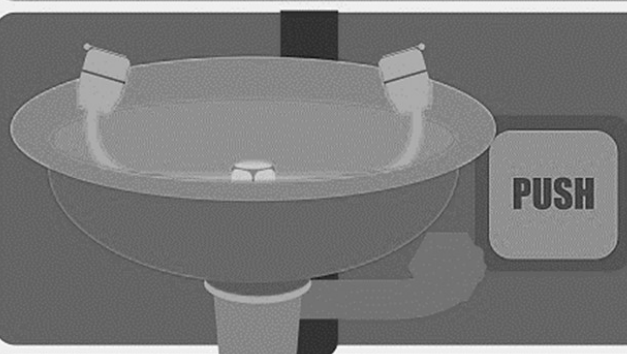


SAVE YOUR SIGHT WITH PROPER EYEWASH STATION USE

If a chemical splashes in your eyes, will you know what to do?

Go immediately to the closest eyewash station.
If possible, yell for help so that another
employee can help you walk safely and quickly
to the eyewash station. The first 10 to 15
seconds after exposure are critical!

**10-15
SECONDS**



Activate the eyewash station.

Flush your eyes continuously for a full 15
minutes while keeping your eyes open
with your fingers. Roll your eyes in all
directions to flush every area of the eye.



If you wear contact lenses, begin flushing over
the lens immediately. Do NOT delay flushing to
remove your lenses. Remove the lenses once
flushing has begun so the chemical is not
trapped in your eyes.

After flushing, seek immediate medical attention.
