


# Evacuation Procedures for Hotels Infographic



**EMERGENCY PROCEDURES**

 In an emergency, please exit using the stairwells and proceed to one of the following evacuation meeting points. Remember, never use the elevator during a fire evacuation.

**EVACUATION MEETING POINTS:**


1. INTERSECTION OF CROSS & DON'T CROSS
2. INTERSECTION OF A ST & AVENUE BRAVO

**SHELTER-IN-PLACE PROCEDURES:**

1. CLOSE AND LOCK ALL DOORS AND WINDOWS.
2. MOVE TO AN INTERIOR ROOM, AWAY FROM WINDOWS.
3. TURN OFF AIR CONDITIONER AND ANY FANS
4. WAIT FOR THE ALL-CLEAR ANNOUNCEMENT

**LOCKDOWN PROCEDURES:**

1. IMMEDIATELY AND CALMLY PROCEED TO THE CLOSEST ROOM.
2. CLOSE AND LOCK ALL DOORS AND WINDOWS. TURN OFF LIGHTS. STAY LOW TO THE GROUND.
3. REMAIN QUIET UNTIL ALL-CLEAR IS GIVEN
