Fireworks Safety Retail Fireworks Sales

- 1. Keep safety areas well accessible.
- 2. Remove all wet materials.
- 3. Establish clear off-the-worksite.
- 4. Minimize clutter, particularly:

 - 5. Know the contingencies involved and operation.
 - 6. Remove and dispose of damaged fireworks.
 - 7. Remove debris immediately, possibly manually.
 - 8. Take safety measures regarding tools and equipment placement.
 - 9. Allow only those working within 50 feet.
 - 10. Keep spectators outside.
