Five Ways to Stay Safe When Working on Chassis in Marine Terminals

- 1** Be aware of vehicle traffic patterns and conduct work in a protected area.
- 2** Disconnect and secure chassis from semi-tractors before performing maintenance or repairs.
- 3** Never position yourself under a jacked vehicle or equipment.
- 4** Follow safety procedures for bleeding pressure from charged brake cylinders before performing work or removing them.
- 5** Service single- and multi-piece rim wheels according to 29 CFR 1910.177 and 1917.44.
