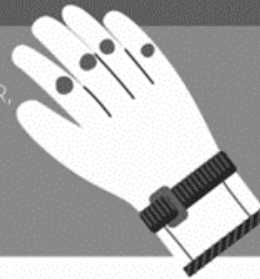

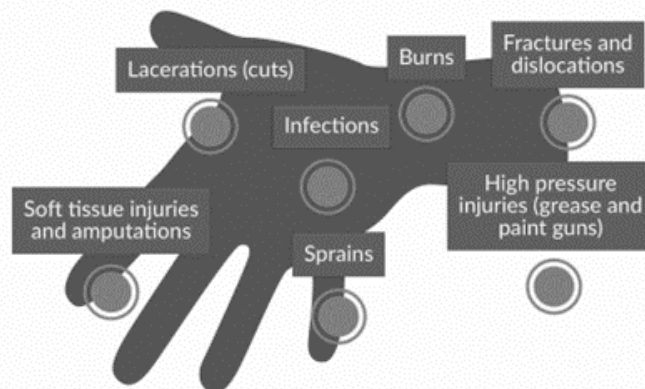


## WHY HAND PROTECTION SHOULD BE YOUR TEAM'S FIRST PRIORITY

## MOST COMMON HAND HAZARDS

Caught between pinch points  
Sharp object hazards  
Slip, trip and fall hazards  
Repetitive stress (ergonomic) hazards  
Line-of-fire hazards



Defective equipment hazards  
Rotating/moving equipment hazards  
Thermal hazards  
Chemical, electrical and pressure hazards  
Inattention hazards
