HOME CARE vs. HOME HEALTH

Discussing the characteristics of and services offered by each

While both home health and home care (or in-home care) services are provided in the home setting, there are sharp differences between each. The biggest difference, according to Caring.com, " ... is that home healthcare is a higher level of care that is deemed medically necessary by a physician."

Also, home health is covered by Medicare, Medicaid and most private insurance plans, while home care is more often paid for privately or sometimes covered by long-term care insurance.
