Overview

The term material handling refers to the moving or adjusting of any large or heavy materials with the assistance of mechanical equipment. OSHA's 29 CFR 1910 Subpart N, regulate the use of machinery or other equipment utilized in the moving of such materials.

Equipment

The following equipment are addressed in Material Handling:

- Forklifts (or any Powered Industrial Truck)
- Cranes
- Derricks
- Slings
- Helicopters
- Servicing of rim wheels
- Conveyors (construction)
- Elevators (construction)
- Mechanized earthmoving equipment (construction)
