RECALLS

Since the establishment of the National Highway Traffic Safety Administration

-  **290 Million** cars, trucks, motorcycles, and mopeds have been recalled for safety reasons.
-  **86 Million** tires
-  **66 Million** pieces of motor vehicle equipment
-  **42 Million** auto seats have also been recalled.

THE DANGERS OF DEFECTIVE CAR PARTS



AIR BAGS

Facts:
Air bags have been required in all passenger vehicles since 1985. Air bags can reduce the risk of death in a front-end collision by 30%. Air bags are intended at a rate of 200 mph.

Common Air Bag Defects:
Fail to inflate in a frontal accident
Inflate too fast
Tear bag
Release at Low Speed Inflation



SEAT BELTS

Facts:
Seat belts save 1,000 lives each year.
Seat belts can reduce the risk of death for a front seat occupant by 50%.
Seat Belts can Cause serious injuries that distract, disorient, restrain, restrain, restrain, or restrain when they fail to perform their function. Seat belt failure can occur because of a faulty design or improper installation.



CAR ROOF

Facts:
Strong car roofs are an important part of a safe car.
Unfortunately, many cars are designed with flat car roofs that must bend during a rollover accident.
Car roofs can be crushed during a rollover accident causing serious injuries.
