Six Facts on Workplace Rules



Odds of winning the lottery: 1 in 135,145,920 (multi-state, mega-millions jackpot) Odds that the boss bends the truth in dealings with staff: 4 in 10 (source: Florida State University survey of 700 employees).

- 1. Three significant problems that untruthful bosses create for their companies include poor morale, reduced productivity and higher employee turnover.
- 2. Psychologically abused workers experience five major symptoms: exhaustion, nervousness, depression, tension and mistrust.
- 3. Twenty-four percent of workers surveyed complained that their supervisor invaded their privacy.
- 4. Asked if their boss made negative comments about them to other employees or managers, 27 percent said "yes."
- 5. Thirty-seven percent of the respondents said their supervisor had failed to give them credit where due.
- 6. Thirty-nine percent of workers surveyed claimed that their supervisor failed to keep promises.
