Steps to Protect Automotive Service Workers from Exposure to Coronavirus

The following steps can help reduce the risk of exposure to the coronavirus for automotive service workers:

- 1 Encourage workers to stay home if they are sick.
- 2 Provide gloves and masks or other face coverings.
- 3 Maintain at least six feet between co-workers and customers, where possible.
- 4 Offer pick-up and drop-off service.
- 5 Close or limit customer in reception areas and waiting rooms.
- 6 Use "no touch" options for payments and appointments.
- 7 Regularly clean and disinfect all tools and equipment.



- 8 Discourage the sharing of tools and equipment.
- 9 Cover seats and sanitize key fobs and steering wheels before and after service.
- 10 Encourage workers to report any safety and health concerns.
