Ten Steps All Workplaces Can Take to Reduce Risk of Exposure to Coronavirus

All mortplaces can take the following infection prevention measures to protect workers:

- Encourage workers to stay home if sick.
- Encourage respiratory etiquette, including covering coughs and sneares.
- Provide a place to wash hands or alcohol-based hand rubs containing at least 60% alcohol.
- Limit workshu access: to only essential sorioers, if possible.
- Establish flexible workshee (e.g., telecommuting) and flexible work hours (e.g., staggered shifts), if feasible.
- Discourage workers from using other workers' phones, desks, or other work tools and equipment.

- Regularly clean and dispolact surfaces, equipment, and other elements of the work environment.
- Use Environmental Protection Agency (EPA)-approved deening chemicals with label claims against the commercia.
- Follow the manufacturer's instructions for use of all cleaning and disinfection products.
- Encourage workers to report any safety and health concerns.
